Type	Description
Placement	Program placement is essential to ensure equitable instruction. Placement assessments are administered one-on-one and assess key aspects of foundational skills and literacy. Placement schedules are used to place students according to performance. Click to view placement tests.

Daily Individual & Unison Responses	Individual & unison responses are built-in to the lesson everyday. Teachers gather essential information from student responses and use these to immediately guide instruction and correct errors.
Daily Independent Work	Students complete textbook and workbook assignments for independent practice of lesson skills. Independent work is assessed and used to guide instruction.
Formal	
Mastery Tests	Mastery tests are administered every 10 lessons and provide a formal assessment of the skills taught in the previous 10 lessons. Skill-specific remediations are provided based on student/group performance.
Oral Reading Fluency	In Grades K - 1, fluency assessment is built-in to the Mastery Tests. Starting in Grade 2, students are assessed every 5 lessons using the digital Oral Reading Fluency Tool that automatically calculates wpm and tracks errors.
